B. New Business:

1. Council heard from Chris Moton about the repairs for lift station 17. He had a quote from GWI and anticipating receiving a second quote from Southern Civil prior to the next city council meeting.
2. Council heard from Chris Morton about the Inert Landfill Limb and Debris Grinding. He reminded council that limb debris must be moved within ninety (90) days from receipt of deposition and the last grinding date for the city was September 2023. He also suggested that council take into consideration the maintenance plan in order to keep the city in compliance with the regulations of the Inert Landfield Limb Debris Disposal.
3. Council heard from John McClellan with Turnipseed Engineers about the Lead Service Line Inventory.
4. Council was presented with a request from Alan Brasher with the Emanuel Arts Council for the closing of the 100 Block of North Green Street for Emanuel Arts Council's Block Party for the Arts on March 28, 2024, 4pm-7pm. A rainout day of April 4th has been set aside in case of inclement weather on March 28th.
5. Council heard a proposal for the purchase of two new tag readers.

6. Council heard from Jenna Hazelet with Servline Utilities about water and sewer insurance for the City of Swainsboro residents.
